2008	JJ Prum <i>Graacher Himmelreich</i> Auslese Goldkapsel <i>Mosel, Germany</i>	15 - Taste 45 - Glass
	<p>The Prüm family history in the Mosel dates back as early as 1156! However, Johann Josef Prüm, founded the J.J. Prüm estate in 1911. The wines from this site often challenge those from its more famous neighbour, especially in hot, dry years. Graacher wines attract with their racy acidity, a pronounced minerality (that reminds of crushed rock) and slightly different fruit aromas and flavours (more in the citrus spectrum). Looking at the vineyard conditions, the hill faces slightly more westwards than the Wehlener Sonnenuhr, i.e. it has a more south-west exposure, it is a little less steep and has deeper soils which act as excellent water reservoirs.</p>	
2012	Jean-Louis Chave <i>l'Hermitage Blanc</i> <i>Hermitage, Northern Rhone Valley, France</i>	35 - Taste 105 - Glass
	<p>The Chave family is one of the oldest names in the world of wine. They have been producing one of the world's greatest wines since 1481! The label bears an inscription commemorating this achievement, "Vignerons de Père en Fils depuis 1481", which is translated to, Vine growers from father to son since 1481. The white wine grapes for Chave are planted in 5 hectares of vines that come from Les Rocoules, L'Hermitage, Peleat, Maison Blanches and other vineyards. Les Rocoules has some of the oldest white wine grapes in the Northern Rhone, with that are more than 80 years old.</p>	
2007	Angelo Gaja <i>Gaia & Rey</i> Chardonnay <i>Langhe, Italy</i>	20 - Taste 60 - Glass
	<p>Not only is this the best Chardonnay in Italy, but it might also be the best Italian white. Deriving in part from Angelo's first Chardonnay vineyard in Treslo with the remainder sourced from Gaja's Serralunga sites, this wine is named for his oldest daughter, Gaia Gaja, and his grandmother, Clotilde Rey. Gaia & Rey is fermented with naturally occurring yeasts found on the grape skins and in the winery, giving the wine an added touch of exoticism. This is a hedonistic wine with lusciously ripe flavours of guava, tangerine, honey, marzipan and oak spice. Impressively chewy in the mouth, the concentrated, ripe fruit is perfectly balanced by lively acidity that holds through the long, lingering finish.</p>	
2013	Weingut Keller <i>Burgel</i> Spatburgunder - Grosses Gewachs <i>Rheinhessen, Germany</i>	13 - Taste 39 - Glass
	<p>The prestigious Keller estate has been in the family for over 220 years. The whole 18ha estate crops lower than 35hl/ha, lower than many Grand Cru vineyards in Burgundy! The wine is aged in only twenty percent new barrels (all the wood for the two Pinot Noir Grosses Gewachs are sourced from Domaine de la Romanee-Conti- so the provenance of the wood is impeccable).</p>	
2009	Chateau Haut-Brion <i>1er Cru Classe</i> <i>Pessac Leognan, Bordeaux, France</i>	150 - Taste 450 - Glass
	<p>The only first growth property from outside the Médoc to be included in the 1855 Classification, Haut-Brion's viticultural history can be traced back further than its Médoc First Growth counterparts. The red wine is no less extraordinary; at its best it displays text-book Graves characteristics of cigar-box, curranty fruit, earth, smoky spice and cassis. The high Merlot content, compared to the Médoc First Growths, gives it a voluptuous edge, but does not in any way detract from its ability to age.</p>
